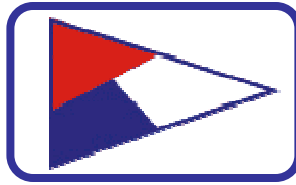

Dear Roton Point Parents,

We are very excited to announce the addition of Rob Trifone as our new Aquatics Director. Rob comes to us with years of coaching and in managing programs and facilities. Rob has made many positive changes in our swim offerings for lessons and clinics. Other changes to our youth programs have been made for this summer to increase participation and safety for our children in the sailing, swimming and tennis programs at Roton Point and minimize overlapping of programs.

Swim team practice will now be 8:45 -9:45am for 10 & under and 9:00-10:30am for 11 & up. The diving team will now practice from 8:45-9:45am for 13 & up and 9:45-10:45 for 12 & under. Our pre-team, the "Lobster Tails", will practice from 10:30 AM to 11:15 AM. The "Lobster Tails" who attend Hobie Camp will be brought down to the pool and picked up as part of their daily routine. These changes allow for the swimmers to participate in sailing and improves their oversight by Hobie Camp.

The Jr. Sailing courses will be from 10:00 AM-1:00 PM and 2:00PM-5:00PM depending on the level of the course. This change makes our sailing program participants safer as they will be learning under weather conditions that are more suitable for the beginner sailor.

Tennis will offer age group times that fit in between the times of the sailing and swimming programs.

Water polo will take place Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 12:30 -2:30 and Thursday evenings from 6:00 - 7:00.

**IN ORDER FOR CHILDREN TO PARTICIPATE IN OUR PROGRAMS REGISTRATION FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED AND PAYMENTS MADE IN FULL. EACH FAMILY MUST COMPLETE AND TURN IN THE "2011 PERMISSION AND INDEMNIFICATION FORM". IF WE DO NOT HAVE THE REQUIRED FORMS AT THE START OF THE ACTIVITY YOUR CHILD MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE ACTIVITY, UNTIL WE HAVE THE FORMS, WITHOUT EXCEPTION.**

Another very important and significant change has been implemented for all Hobie Camp parents, with increasing numbers of Hobie Campers at Roton Point, It has been decided to prohibit traffic in the Grove during drop-off and pick-up periods. This past year, we experienced a great deal of congestion during drop off and pick up times. With this added congestion safety concerns surfaced with the headaches of traffic backup and erratic movement. The interaction between parents and the drop off and pick up times is an integral part of the relationships that are built between Hobie Camp and our families. Unfortunately, with cars stacked up or waiting, these conversations were cut short. Safety is our ultimate concern at Camp. Parents will park their cars in the parking lot and walk their children to the counselor staging area in the Grove. We realize this may be inconvenient to some parents with younger children not going to Camp, but we plan for safety over convenience.

## **2011 Roton Point Junior Sailing**

This informational package includes registration forms for the junior sailing program. There are a few changes to the program so please read this information carefully. We expect another busy summer for the program and therefore we suggest you sign up in advance to reserve a space for each class. All 2011 unit owners and licensees that have children between the ages of 8 – 18 are eligible to participate.

**Instructors** – Roton Point is pleased to announce that our head instructor this year is Jesse Buccolo. For the past 3 summers, Jesse taught sailing at Beach Point Yacht Club where he was the racing coach for the Optimist sailors. Our returning instructors are Peter “Tally” Thoren, Sarah Smith and Sean Spinney. Also joining our staff this year are Dylan Curran and Michelle Fink. Dylan taught for one year at Noroton Yacht Club and Michelle instructed at Weeburn. All of our instructors have significant sailing and racing experience in junior sailing programs and have completed the US Sailing level 1 Instructors Course, First Aid & CPR, and have safe boat licenses.

**Swim Requirements** – All participants must demonstrate that they are comfortable around the water and pass a supervised swim test in the Long Island Sound prior to the start of their sailing programs.

**2011 Sign-Ups** – Complete and sign the 2011 Permission and Indemnification Form and the Junior Sailing application, and return them along with payment as soon as possible to RPA, P.O. Box 116, Rowayton, CT 06853.

**JSA Membership** – **MANDATORY**...All participants in the sailing program must join the Junior Sailing Association of Long Island Sound (JSA). The membership fee is \$65.00 and is non-refundable. As a member, you will receive the JSA summer newsletter listing all events, activities and general sailing information. The fees for junior sailing and JSA are combined in one payment and are paid directly to Roton Point.

**JSA Online Waiver Database** – **MANDATORY**... The Junior Sailing Association of Long Island Sound requires that every sailor to register in the JSA Waiver Database. Registration is done at <https://www.jsalis.org/db/login.php>

**United States Optimist Dinghy Association Membership** – Optimists sailors that qualify for the Opti Champs must be members of the USODA. Register at [www.usoda.org](http://www.usoda.org)

**Pixel Class Membership – Mandatory for Pixel Sailors** – All Pixel sailors must be members of the Pixel Class Association in order to compete in regattas. The director of sailing will register you with the association and then bill you directly. Estimated fees are \$25.00.

**C420 Class Membership – Mandatory for C420 Sailors** – All C420 sailors must register with the Club 420 Association to participate in regattas. Register at [www.club420.org](http://www.club420.org)

**Boat Check and Junior Sailing Orientation** – Orientation for all sailors and parents will be held prior to the start of the season for all sailors participating in the sailing program. The orientation will provide an overview of the junior sailing program, discuss the changes to the program and include a boat and safety check. This meeting is essential for the smooth operation of the junior sailing program. Registered junior sailors and their parents will be notified of the date and time of the meeting in early June.

**Boat Usage** - Participants who sail in the Optimist and C420 programs must provide their own boat. All registrants in the Pixel program will be charged a \$100.00 general maintenance fee.

The Boat Locker will purchase Lasers and 420s on April 2<sup>nd</sup> and Optimists on April 9<sup>th</sup>. They will sell Lasers and 420s on April 3<sup>rd</sup> and Optimists on April 10<sup>th</sup>. If you miss either date they will purchase boats on April 16<sup>th</sup> and sell boats on April 17<sup>th</sup>. For more details visit <http://www.boatlocker.com>.

Please contact the office if you are willing to lease your boat to another member for the summer. Your name will be put on a contact list and those members that wish to lease a boat for the summer can contact you.

**Boat Storage** – Optimist sailors will be assigned to a specific berth for the summer. Berth assignments will not be given out prior to Memorial Day weekend.

**Boat Registration** - If you own a new boat or are leasing a boat for the summer from either a member or an outside entity your boat must be registered. Boat registration stickers from last year are valid as long as they are attached to the boat and the numbers are legible. Registration stickers can be obtained in the summer office starting on Memorial Day weekend.

**Clothing/Gear** – All students must wear a properly fitting U.S Coast Guard approved life jacket, soft solid shoes (“Tevas” or old sneakers are acceptable... Flip-flops and Crocs are NOT acceptable) and sunscreen at all times. Each sailor should have a water bottle with the junior sailor’s name on it. A wind breaker, foul weather gear, hats and sunglasses are highly recommended.

Please write your name on all sails, bags, rudders, life jackets, bags, etc... These items are easily mixed up and hard to find once they are misplaced.

**Health Concerns** - Please make the instructors aware of any possible health issues that are not indicated on the JSA Waiver form provided. Your child will be in the sun and on the water for a good portion of the class. Please send your child to class with any medication they could possibly need in a waterproof pouch.

**Races and Regattas** – The Junior Sailing Association of Long Island Sound (JSA of LI) sponsors many junior sailing regattas for Optimists, Pixels and C420s. We strongly encourage any qualified sailor to participate in these regattas. The regatta experience is unique because the sailors test their skills independently without the coaching of an instructor. Parents, not the instructors, are responsible for the transportation of their child to and from all regattas. Regatta fees are independent of the normal junior sailing registration fees.

**Junior Sailing Barbeque and Catamaran Rides with RPSA** – On Sunday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, the members of the Roton Point Sailing Association will host a barbeque for the junior sailors and their families. They will supply hamburgers, cheeseburgers, hotdogs and drinks. We ask the families to bring either a desert or a side dish. After everyone eats we will then set sail on the RPSA members’ catamarans.

**Roton Point “Green” Fleet Optimist Regatta** – Roton Point will host our 5<sup>th</sup> Annual “Green” Fleet Regatta on Wednesday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. Afternoon sailors are encouraged to attend the event and to cheer on our youngest sailors. Afternoon sailing will take place on this day.

**JSA of LIS Pixel-Blue Jay Championships/Blue Jay National Championships** – Roton Point and Noroton Yacht Club will co-host this year’s championships. The dates of the event which were established by JSA are on Monday, August 8 and Tuesday, August 9<sup>th</sup>. Registration for the event is on Sunday afternoon, August 7<sup>th</sup>. Parents are needed to volunteer their time as committee chairs, race day workers and provide housing for sailors. If you are interested see John Cross starting Memorial Day weekend.

**Classes Will Not Meet** – Classes will not meet on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, July 4<sup>th</sup> and on August 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.

**Awards Dinner** – The Junior Sailing Awards dinner is tentatively scheduled for Friday, August 5<sup>th</sup>. This special event is open to all family members. Afternoon sailing classes will end at 4:00 on this day.

**Parent Volunteers** – Knowledge of sailing is not a requirement for our volunteers. Volunteers are needed for the Green Fleet Regatta as well as the Awards Dinner. In addition, any parent that wishes to be part of the Jr. Sailing Parent Committee should contact John Cross.

## 2011 Roton Point Junior Sailing Programs and Course Descriptions

The goal of the Roton Point Junior Sailing is to have every sailor fall in love with sailing. Students will learn to sail in a nurturing atmosphere as they achieve specific developmental sailing benchmarks. Experienced sailors are exposed to racing and encouraged to attend JSA regattas on the Sound. All of our instructors have significant sailing and racing experience in junior sailing programs and have completed the US Sailing level 1 Instructors Course, First Aid & CPR, and have safe boat licenses. More importantly, they love sailing and working with children.

The program services children from the age of eight to eighteen. Our classes range from 1 week introductory classes to a full 5 week summer sailing program. Embedded in the program are social events for the sailor and their families to further enrich the junior sailing experience.

The sailing instructors assess each sailor's performance throughout the summer and then recommend them for the appropriate sailing level for the following season.

### **Course Descriptions – Optimist Level**

**June 20<sup>th</sup> - June 24<sup>th</sup>**

**Classes will not meet on June 22<sup>nd</sup>**

**Optimist Beginner Course - \$180.00:** This course is for the first time optimist sailor who will be at least 8 years old during the summer. This program prepares the sailor for the full Junior Sailing Program. The main objectives of the program are for the sailors to learn the parts of the Opti, be comfortable in an Opti on the water, leave the beach, and rig and de-rig their boats. The mastering of these objectives and a small instructor to sailor ratio makes for a successful transition into the main Junior Sailing Program. **If a first time optimist sailor does not enroll in this program they will not be able to participate in the Junior Sailing Program from June 27<sup>th</sup> – August 5<sup>th</sup>.** Sailing lessons with an instructor are an acceptable substitute for this program if this week cannot be attended. Please contact John Cross at [asstmgr@rotonpoint.org](mailto:asstmgr@rotonpoint.org) to make arrangements. Sailors must provide their own vessel and pass a swim test.

**Pre Season Warm-Up - \$144.00:** This course is for the Optimist sailor with one or more years of experience who would like to start sailing before the start of the full program. This is a great way to freshen up on those sailing skills that might have been lost since last summer. Sailors must provide their own vessel.

**June 20<sup>th</sup> - August 5<sup>th</sup>**

**Classes will not meet on June 22<sup>nd</sup> or July 4<sup>th</sup>**

**Optimist Race Team – \$900.00-** This 7 week program is for the Intermediate and/or Advanced Optimist level sailor that has achieved advanced bench marks in the JSA of Long Island Sound curriculum and would like to move beyond recreational sailing and into a more competitive format. Intermediate and Advanced Optimist sailors are paired in the same class. Instruction is tailored to the individual sailor as they continue to develop their sailing skills via water and classroom instruction. Sailors will compete in regattas throughout the summer. Team members are automatically entered into the scheduled regattas and they will participate in these events as if they were on any other athletic team. The goal of these sailors is to qualify and attend the Optimist Championship.

The projected 2011 schedule provides an idea of the dates and locations of each regatta.

The director of junior sailing must be notified in writing at the start of the season of any potential conflicts with regatta attendance, failure to do so will result in nonrefundable regatta fees. Parents are responsible for transportation to and

from each regatta. A full time commitment must be made by both the sailor and their parents. Additional fees are paid by each sailor to cover regatta expenses.

**June 27<sup>th</sup> – August 5<sup>th</sup>**

**Classes will not meet on July 4<sup>th</sup>**

**Junior Sailing Course - \$900.00:** This 6 week course develops the young sailor by helping them to master curricular performance objectives. This course is for all experienced junior sailors and those sailors that participated in the beginner sailing course. Any individual that is new to Roton Point and is an experienced sailor must be assessed by our head instructor. Sailors must provide their own vessel. Classes will begin at 10:00 AM and end at 1:00 PM. If your child is a swim team participant the instructors will meet the sailors at swim team practice and bring them to sailing.

- **Opti 1 – This is a course for the beginning sailor.** They will follow the JSA of Long Island Sound curriculum but will also have an infusion of weekly activities that build an out of water excitement for sailing. Sailors will participate in Pirate Day and Halloween at Sea. Sailors may participate in the Roton Point “Green Fleet Regatta” if they can successfully sail upwind, get into the safety position and demonstrate skills that allow them to round a mark and participate in a start. **A prerequisite for this course is the “Optimist Beginner Course” or through private sailing lessons.**
- **Opti 2 – This course is for the sailor that has completed at least one year of junior sailing.** Sailors will continue to develop their sailing skills through on water, land and classroom instruction and they will be slowly introduced to racing. Sailors will participate in Pirate Day and Halloween at Sea. The highlight of the season will occur when the sailors participate in the Roton Point “Green Fleet Regatta.” **Based on 2010 recommendation.**
- **Opti 3 – This course is for the sailor that has completed at least two years of junior sailing.** Sailors will continue to develop their sailing skills via water, land and classroom instruction. This afternoon class provides a different sailing experience as the sailors learn to sail in a more challenging weather environment. This is a great alternative for those sailors that are unsure whether or not they are ready for the competitive race team. Instruction will focus on the development of race skills and techniques as well as an introduction to navigation. The instructors will encourage the sailors to participate in the Opti race schedule once their skill set is suitable for competitive regattas. **Based on 2010 recommendation.**

---

**August 10<sup>th</sup> - August 12<sup>th</sup>**

**“Is Sailing For Me?”** - \$135.00: This course is for the first time optimist sailor who wants to try sailing. This is a great opportunity for the children to see if they may want to sail during the 2012 season. The main objectives of the program are for the sailors to learn the parts of the Opti, be comfortable in an Opti on the water, leave the beach, and rig and de-rig their boats. Sailors must provide their own vessel and pass a swim test.

**Optimist Continuation Course** - \$108.00: This course is an extension of the summer course for the Opti 1 and Opti 2 sailors that want to further their skills. The emphasis during this week is the development of racing skills.

## Course Descriptions – Pixels and C420s

This class is designed to meet the many needs of the older Roton Point sailor. The Pixel includes a crew of 2-3 sailors that are at least 11 years of age and have a minimum combined weight of 190 pounds. The C420 class includes a crew of 2-3 sailors that are at least 14 years of age and have a minimum combined weight of 220 pounds. Classes are not for those individuals that will miss any portion of the sailing class because the sailors will work as a team throughout the summer.

The Roton Point Sailing Association purchased an additional Pixel last summer to bring our Fleet to a total of 5 vessels. Our total enrollment is limited to 10 -12 sailors, unless a member provides their own vessel. Our school does not own any 420s therefore these boats must be provided by the owner.

All Pixel users must sign a waiver stating that they are financially responsible for any major damage done to the Pixel during the course of the summer and pay a \$100.00 general maintenance fee.

### Pixels and C420s

**June 20<sup>th</sup> - August 5<sup>th</sup> – \$900.00**

**Classes will not meet on June 22<sup>nd</sup> or July 4<sup>th</sup>**

This class is for the sailor who wishes to develop their doubled handed sailing skills and sail competitively. Pixel and C420 sailors will compete in informal interclub practices and races throughout the summer. Prior optimist racing experience is suggested for success in this class. Sailors will be able to attend their first regatta when their instructor feels that they will benefit from the experience. A full time commitment must be made by both the sailor and their parents. The class meets daily from 2:00 – 5:00. Additional fees are paid by the sailor to cover regatta expenses.

**Pixel Boat General Maintenance Fee - \$100.00:** This fee covers the general replacement of Pixel parts that break or are damaged during the season. The fee does not cover damage done to the hull, mast, rudder, center board, sails or other major rigging equipment. This fee does not have to be paid if you provide your own boat.

## Jesse Buccolo – Head Sailing Instructor



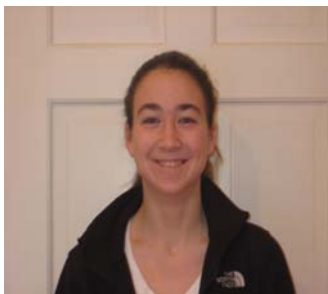

## 2011 Aquatics Program



We are pleased to announce that Rob Trifone will join us as Roton Point's Aquatics Director.

Rob has been coaching and managing summer aquatic programs since 1994. He began his Fairfield County Swimming League (FCSL) coaching career at the Middlesex Club and then moved on to Woodway Country Club, where he has been the head coach of swimming and the aquatics director for the past 11 years. Rob has been involved in all levels of aquatic programs from lessons, to coaching water polo and swimming, and even to refereeing throughout the FCSL.

Rob has been an educator and a coach for the past 32 years in Fairfield County. He currently teaches biology and marine biology at Darien High School, where he is also head football coach. He is an eight-time "high school coach of the year" in both football and track, including the Connecticut coach of the year and the National Football Foundation coach of the year.

Rob has met with our staff, Board of Directors, and committees, and has been actively involved in the planning of the entire youth packet to ensure that it works with all of our youth activities.

Rob will be joining us on a limited basis until school is out. As soon as school ends (as is the

case with our department heads who teach), he will be at the club full time. You will have many opportunities to meet Rob, his wife Marge, and their children Kevin, Jenny, Christian, Bobby and Mark. They'll be at the New Member Reception on Sunday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> from 3-5 PM, and at the annual Commissioning Ceremony at 3 PM on Monday of the Memorial Day weekend, when we officially open up the Club for the 2011 season. Please take the time to introduce yourself to him while at the Club and help make Rob and his family feel right at home with a warm Roton Point welcome.

**Rock Lobster Swim and Dive Team:** The swim team consists of children from 5-17 years of age. Practice officially starts on June 20<sup>th</sup> and occurs every week day from **8:45-9:45 AM 10 & Under, 9:00-10:30 AM 11 & Up**. There are four (4) evening practices from 6:00 – 7:00 PM on June 6<sup>th</sup>, June 8<sup>th</sup>, (June 6<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> are for 8 and under only) June 13<sup>th</sup>, and June 15<sup>th</sup>. (13<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> are for all age groups). Rock Lobster swim team members can also sign up to participate in weekly stroke technique group lessons: **Rock Lobster Stroke Technique** (9 & Up) Monday-Thursday 2:30-3:00 (concentrates on different strokes each week-see lesson schedule below)

**The Diving Team** consists of children from 7-17 years of age. Practice begins on June 20<sup>th</sup>. Practice occurs from **8:45-9:45 AM 13 & Up, 9:45-10:45 AM 12 and Under**. The competitive team consists of experienced divers that can perform the dives needed for the competition in their age groups.

**Lobster Tails Swim Team:** The Lobster Tails swim program is designed to act as a feeder program for the Rock Lobsters swim team. Participants are between 5 and 9 years of age and must be able to swim one length of the pool unassisted. Practices are Monday through Friday from 10:30 till 11:15 and there are at least two Lobster Tails only swim meets. The program will run from the swim team pre-season practices (see above) until August 3<sup>rd</sup>. Practice will focus on stroke development and racing techniques, it is not swim lessons. The Lobster Tails will be able to practice and participate with the Rock Lobsters swim team by coach's invitation. If your child participates in Hobie Camp they will be escorted by a counselor to and from practice during the hours of camp. Hobie campers that are chosen for the Rock Lobsters swim team will practice with the Lobster Tails. Decisions on which team your child should be a part of will be made by the coaches at the pre-season practices. All Lobster Tail participants are welcome to sign up for additional swim lesson programs that are offered 4 days/week from 1:30-2 PM. **Dory (6 & 7 year olds) and Crush (8 & 9 year olds)** will have one coach/6 swimmers and the participants will be taught the proper techniques for freestyle, backstroke, (as well as butterfly and breaststroke for the more advanced swimmers), block starts & finishes. Space is limited because of the 6 to 1 coach to swimmer ratio.

**Water Polo Team:** The Water Polo team this year will focus on building fundamental skills, as well as preparing the teams to be competitive with other clubs in the FCSL. The team is open to children between 8 and 17 years old that can swim one length of the pool, as well as tread water for 5 minutes. Practices are held 4 days a week, Monday through Wednesdays **12:30-1:30 PM, On Thursdays practice will be 6- 7 PM (No 12:30 practice on Thursdays).**

**Working Teens:** Teenagers, 15 years of age and older, that work and are not able to attend practice on a daily basis can be on the team at a reduced cost.

## **ROTON POINT SWIM LESSON PROGRAMS:**

Weekly group lesson programs begin Monday June 20<sup>th</sup> and run 4 days/week for 30 min, Monday through Thursday with a Friday make-up. There is limited space for all group lessons as we always maintain a 6-1 coach to swimmer ratio. All programs are staffed by certified coaches or WSI swim instructors. Cost is \$ 80/ 2 weeks (**Because of schools getting out at different times the first 2 week sessions will be offered in 1 week blocks at \$ 40/1 week**). If you sign up for all 6 weeks the cost will be \$ 200 for the entire summer (1 week free). There is no pro-rating.

- **Dory** (6 & 7 year olds) Max 12 participants 1:30-2:00 Monday-Thursdays  
Dory is a group lesson for 6 & 7 year olds that are beginning to swim independently, comfortable in water, front and back float w/o assistance. Rhythmic breathing introduced, beginning freestyle technique, streamline push off. Backstroke skills will also be introduced. This will be a good lesson complement for any lobster tail swimmers as well.
- **Crush** (8 & 9 year olds) Max 12 participants 1:30-2:00 Monday to Thursdays  
Crush is a group lesson for swimmers who are interested in beginning to work on all four strokes. Swimmers will be taught proper technique & drills as well as block starts & finishes. This will be a good lesson complement to any lobster tail swimmers as well.
- **Nemo** (4 & 5 year olds) Max 12 participants 2-2:30 Monday to Thursdays  
Nemo is a group lesson for novice swimmers ages 4-5. These are designed to orient pre-school-age children to the aquatic environment and to begin working on basic aquatic skills such as blowing bubbles through the mouth and nose, go under water, kicking, basic freestyle skills, retrieve submerged objects and learn how to be water safe.
- **Rock Lobster Stroke Technique** (9 & Up) Max 18 participants 2:30-3:00 Monday to Thursdays  
Stroke technique is a group lesson for Rock Lobster swim team members who would like to concentrate on and perfect certain strokes. Each week we will concentrate on a different stroke and work on various skills & drills used to improve your technique. The program will also include block starts, turns and finishes of that particular stroke.
  - Week 1 (June 20<sup>th</sup>) Freestyle
  - Week 2 (June 27<sup>th</sup>) Breaststroke
  - Week 3 (July 5<sup>th</sup>) Backstroke
  - Week 4 (July 11<sup>th</sup>) Butterfly
  - Week 5 (July 18<sup>th</sup>) IM & all 4 Strokes
  - Week 6 (July 25<sup>th</sup>) All 5 Strokes

**WEEKEND CLINICS** (30 min to 1 hour lessons depending on age group) Space is limited as we will keep a 6-1 coach to swimmer ratio. 3 coaches (including guest coaches) will be on hand coaching the weekend clinics.

\*\*You can sign up, or simply show up for weekend clinics in the summer office during the season.

- 1) **SPRING WARM-UP**- Early Spring warm-up for Rock Lobster swim team members ages 9 and over. The clinic will include basic stroke mechanics for all 4 strokes. Ages 9 & 10= 45 min (\$ 15) , 11 and up =1 hour (\$ 20).
  - Saturday May 28<sup>th</sup> 2 PM (Swim suit fitting is 1-3 PM),
  - Saturday June 4<sup>th</sup> 12 noon
- 2) **START & TURN CLINICS**-Series of weekend clinics for all Rock Lobster swim team members concentrating on block starts for all 4 strokes, turns for all 50 meter events and IM turns as well as proper finishes for all 4 strokes.
  - Every Saturday beginning June 11<sup>th</sup> @ 12 noon Ages 10 and under= 45 min (\$ 15), 11 and up =1 hour (\$ 20).

**Swim Suits:** This year we will have the same suit as last year. The team fitting will take place Memorial Day weekend on the hotel porch on Saturday, May 28th, from 1:00-3:00 PM (\* You can sign up for our Spring Warm up Clinic if you are interested from 2- 3 PM). To ensure that your child has a suit by the first swim meet, your order must be placed by Memorial Day. If you have any questions please call the office. 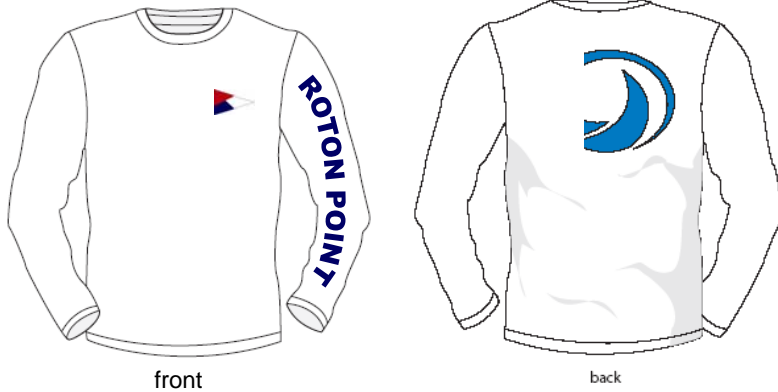

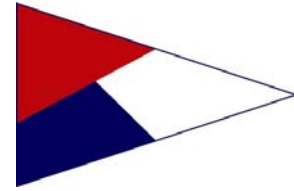
